

Surgical Innovations (AIM:SUN), the designer and manufacturer of creative solutions for Minimally Invasive Surgery (MIS), was featured on national media as a successful example of the recent economic growth in the UK. Channel 4 News and Sky News were at the SI headquarters in Leeds last Friday to film footage for their evening news bulletins.

Sky News has done a live interview with Graham following the official announcement that the economic output in the UK rose by 0.8% between July and September, creating a momentum of economic growth for the first time since in six years. The Office for National Statistics said there had been a "fairly strong" performance across all sectors. The data builds on a 0.7% GDP rise in the April-June period and is the best quarterly performance since 2010.
